

Castlewood Makerspace Makers Moment Pumpkin Centerpiece

Learn to create a pumpkin floral centerpiece



I recommend reading through the entire tutorial before starting

Materials Needed

- Pumpkin
(real or hollow plastic)
- Serrated Knife
- Scissors
- Vase/Glass
- Newspaper
- Deep Spoon
- Fall Flowers
- Flower Food
- Sharpie
- Water



Step 1

Gather all your materials.

Set up a workspace with newspaper.

Using a sharpie, trace the bottom of your vase to the top of your pumpkin.



Step 2

Carefully use the serrated knife to carve the top of the pumpkin.



Step 3

It may take a few turns, but once the top has been cut and feels loose- pull it out.



Step 4

Use the deep spoon to scoop out the seeds from the pumpkin.

*Roast the pumpkin seeds for a delicious snack!



Step 5

Once you've cleared the pumpkin seeds.

Insert the vase.



Step 6

Open and sprinkle your flower food into the vase.



Step 7

Add water inside the vase



Step 8

Gather your flowers and scissors.



Step 9

Decide how tall you want your flowers to stand

You want a tall, medium, short variety to create a globe of flowers in the pumpkin



Step 10

Once you've cut your lengths

You want to remove all the green foliage on the stem that may sit in the water.



Step 11

Arrange your flowers from small (sitting closer to the base) and work your way up.

* If you find your base is exposed you can add moss or other foliage to cover the hole in the pumpkin.



Beautiful!

Now show it off on the dining table!
